## Celebrating, Proclaiming, Serving and Sharing

I'm grateful for the small crew that has stepped forward and stepped up over the last year to form a new stewardship & generosity committee. I'm also grateful that our chair, Diane Schoolitz, has brought materials with her from her previous congregation, shared with their permission and adapted contextually for our use, so that we haven't had to reinvent the wheel this spring.

If you haven't already, you should soon receive something in the mail from Calvary, even if your primary modes of communication with us are electronic. Included is a letter explaining what we're doing and what we're hoping to accomplish, a flyer fleshing out some of what we've done together over the last year with the resources God has entrusted to us, and two cards for you to return either as an act of worship or outside worship at your convenience.

One question I've heard is, "Why are we asking people to make a commitment so far out of step with our budget cycle?" That's a good question with an important answer. We have very intentionally put this stewardship campaign completely out of sync with our budget process.

Why? When our finance committee puts on their budget planning hats, we take a cold, hard look at what has actually been coming in and make spending proposals based on those numbers. But when our stewardship committee puts on their generosity-provoking hats, we are no longer talking about cold, hard realities, but rather dreaming about the future. What is God calling us into? What could we do together, if money

were no constraint? What untapped resources do we already have among us, financial, tangible or intangible? What time and talents and skills and gifts are just waiting to be unleashed when we tap into God's imagination for us?

So you won't be hearing about the budget this time of year – although we ended 2024 in the black! You won't hear about restraining spending or all the other things we do to use the resources you have entrusted to us responsibly. Instead, you're going to hear about the amazing work that God is doing at Calvary right now, work that new people are being drawn to, and the work beyond Calvary's walls that is made possible with the resources you have entrusted to your congregational leadership.

You'll hear about how we've been celebrating God's love, proclaiming the Gospel, serving our neighbors, and above all, sharing deeply, widely and broadly the abundance that God has showered upon us all.

Serving as a Greeter is a calling and a vital ministry in welcoming every person who enters Calvary. We need you! Greeters welcome our members, friends, and visitors. First impressions are lasting, and we believe Calvary is a sharing and caring congregation open to everyone.

At least two members are needed as greeters each Sunday before service — one at the front church main door, and one at the back door entrance. Greeters provide a warm smile, a handshake, and a friendly welcome to all. It is nice to work in pairs.

#### **GREETER RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- •Wear your name badge, as well as the red "greeter badge."
- •Arrive 30 minutes prior to the start of worship.
- •Open the door for each person, if possible.
- •Greet each person with a smile, a warm hello, and offer your hand for a handshake.
- •Introduce yourself to guests or re-connect with people you know.
- •Provide basic church information, such as the location of restrooms, water fountains, nursery, etc.
- •Invite guests to print their names in the guest book and direct them to an Usher for a Sunday bulletin.
- •Stay at your post until the first hymn has begun, so those who arrive late will be welcomed.

Invite guests to stay for Sunday school, adult Bible study and/or any planned fellowship activities.


